**What should I already know?**

- I can make marks with a variety of implements e.g. pencils, pens, paint brushes, crayons, felt tips.

What can I use to make marks?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I can make marks using a variety of implements, including pastels, chalk, charcoal and sticks.</li> </ul>

Can I change the way that the marks look by the way that I perform the action?	<p>I can change the appearance of the marks that make by</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pressing harder/applying less pressure</li> <li>• Holding the implement in a different way e.g. shading using the side of the pencil</li> </ul> <p>Trying out different techniques e.g. smudging, adding more detail, adding another colour on top of an existing mark etc.</p>

**Vocabulary**

chalk	a soft type of rock that can be used for mark making
change	to make something appear different
charcoal	a type of black material used to make marks
detail	features (as in to add extra features to the piece of work).
draw	to make a picture or representation.
mark make	the appearance of a mark on a surface following an action
paint	to make a picture or representation using a specific material
pastel	a soft colouring material using in the form of a stick.
stick	a thin piece of wood

- Manipulate a pencil in order to make a mark.
- Manipulate a pencil with increasing control.
- Manipulate a pencil with the intention to create a representation of someone or something.
- Augment initial drawing by adding extra details.

- Experiment with techniques such as adding more pressure/less pressure, shading, smudging, applying another colour on top of an existing colour etc
