**What should I already know?**

#### Art Skills and Techniques

- Techniques and skills for painting with ready mix paint.
- Colour mixing using ready mix paint to change the colour from the original.
- Learning to paint with powder paints- learning the technique (initially without mixing colours).
- Colour mixing using powder paint to create a different colour from the original.
- Adding black or white to ready mix or to powder paint to change the colour of the paint.
- Learning the technique for painting with watercolours.
- Experimenting with using different tools (other than a brush or fingers) to paint.
- Being able to make a considered choice of colour for a particular purpose.
