What is collage?	Collage from the French: coller, "to glue" or "to stick together" is a technique of art creation, in which art results from an assemblage of different forms, thus creating a new whole.
How can images be manipulated to create pictures?	Use photos. Cut, rearrange overlap and glue to create an image of a face.
How do you cut and reassemble photographs to create a new image?	Create a photomontage. Cut, rearrange, overlap and glue photographs to create new image.

Vocabulary

collage	collage from the french: coller, "to glue" or "to stick together" is a technique of art creation, primarily used in the visual arts by which art results from an assemblage of different forms, thus creating a new whole.
manipulate	to handle or control a tool in a skilful manner.
photomontage	photomontage is the process and the result of making a composite photograph by cutting, gluing, rearranging and overlapping two or more photographs into a new image.
replicate	make an exact copy of; reproduce.

David Hockney, OM, CH, RA is a British painter, draftsman, printmaker, stage designer, and photographer. As an important contributor to the pop art movement of the 1960s, he is considered one of the most influential British artists of the 20th century.



Hannah Höch

German artist
