English

We will also be using Who Let the Gods Out by Maz Evans. We will get plenty of writing practice by crafting responses to both texts, as well as creating information texts about our Mayan history topic.

As ever, we will be giving a high priority to handwriting, reading fluency and spellings. These will be benefitted by practise at home as well as at school.

PE

In PE, Year 5 will be working on their skills netball. First, they will work on their netball skills, passing and shooting a ball while working in a team. We hope to have some more (healthy!) competition between 5BA and 5M after the success of our cricket match.

Art / Design Technology

As we have completed our Art topic on David Hockney, we will be focusing now on Design and Technology. In Design and Technology, we shall be creating work in a variety of methods, such as tie-dye and sewing. The projects shall have an African theme.

Maths

To continue our mathematical investigation in Autumn 2, we will be discussing statistics and their use in our lives. This will include line graphs and timetables. We will use problem solving and reasoning skills throughout the module also.
