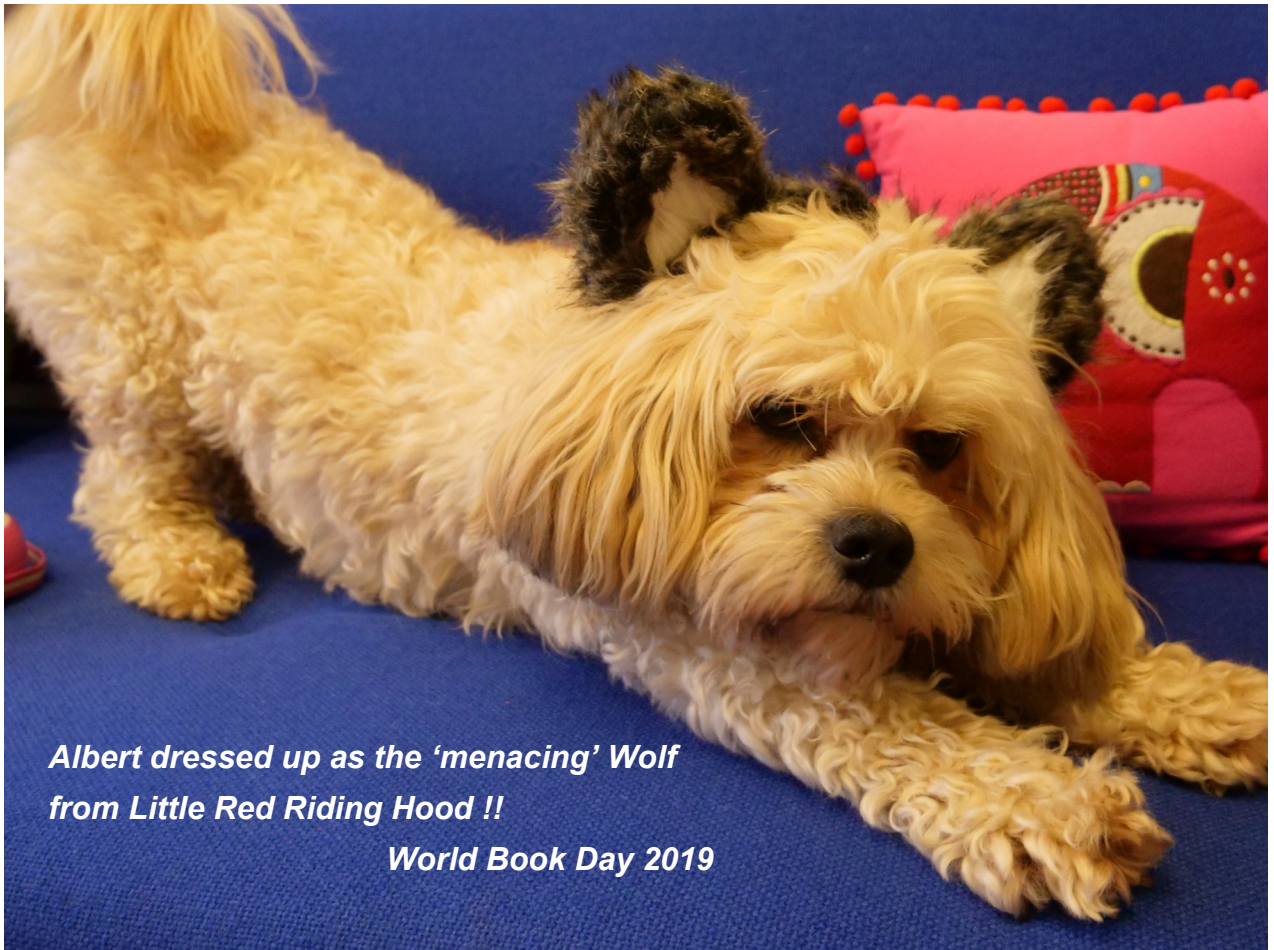

Please do not forget to wrap up warm under your costumes and have warm coats, scarves, hats and gloves for playtime.

Not only is it the beginning of March, but classroom windows will continue to remain open as part of the recommended Covid safety measures to ensure good ventilation.

## A reminder of our Covid Secure Measures

Whilst we are all looking forward to all children coming back to school as well as the gradual easing of lockdown, now is not the time to let down our guard. Whilst case numbers have been falling during lockdown, we are still in the middle of a pandemic which is not stopping anytime soon and the virus is still prevalent in our community. During lockdown, we managed to open up to approximately 160 children of critical workers and vulnerable children every day. We managed to do this during January and February without any bubbles 'popping'. However, we are aware of people within our community who did contract covid during this time. It is essential that everyone follows government guidance and remains extra vigilant.

All the arrangements that were in place before the Christmas Holiday remain in place. This includes:

- Staggered start and finish times.
- The Year Group Bubbles are maintained
- Enhanced hygiene, cleaning
- Increased ventilation—wrap up warm!
- School uniform as usual - but trainers allowed to encourage more active playtimes
- Come to school in PE Kit on your PE day

The contingency arrangements for home learning will remain in place for those isolating and



should a Bubble have to close.

**As before, if anyone in a household is displaying symptoms and/or waiting the results of a Covid test, pupils MUST NOT COME TO SCHOOL.**

The safe systems of working we have in place, together with our local response protocol and incidence management system, will ensure we continue to work together to minimise the impact of Covid-19 on both pupils and staff. It is also down to us as staff, children, parents and community to do everything we can to reduce our risk of transmission outside of school. I would urge everyone in our community to follow the national **Hands, Face, Space** directions in our daily lives, including when gathering outside school, at drop off and pick up times.

As before Christmas, we request that those collecting or dropping off children wear a face covering.

It would be sensible to bear in mind the advice to "*presume everyone we meet could be Covid positive*" when coming onto the school site.

We have all pulled together to keep our community members safe over the past year. We are now hopefully in the last leg and need to keep doing our utmost to keep each other safe.

## Reminder of our Staggered Operation of School

### Morning drop off

- All entrances and exits will be open (No parents are permitted to use the car park – they will not be allowed through)
- All children to arrive at school between 8.30am and 9.00am
- Parents/ carers are asked to spread their arrival times out between 8.30am and 9.00am to avoid congestion
- No parents/carers are allowed to enter any part of the school building including the office.
- Gates will be locked straight after 9.00am
- All classrooms (except for Years 3 and 6) have an external door from their classroom directly to the outside. Children in all of these classes are to enter via their external classroom door directly into their classroom.
- Year 3 children only, are to enter via the normal year 3 doorway
- Year 6 children only, are to enter via the normal Year 4-6 doorway
- Parents must drop off and leave the school site promptly. They are requested to wear a face mask on the school site. They must not congregate on site or by the school gates.
- Only 1 parent/ carer should accompany their child to/from school
- KS2 children arriving unaccompanied must not arrive early and must enter directly into class
- Parents late for drop off will only be allowed to enter via the pedestrian gate at the front of the school. They will need to report via the office.

### Afternoon pick up

- Children in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 must be picked up by an adult as per normal.
- Children in Years 3 to 6 may make their own way home, at their designated leaving time, as per normal.
- Parents should arrive according to the staggered collection time.
- Parents must socially distance whilst on site and leave the school site promptly. They must not congregate or socialise on site. They are requested to wear a face mask on the school site.
- Year 3 and Year 6 children will leave at 3.20pm from their normal entrance
- Children in other year groups have a staggered collection time.

Year 6	3.20	Year 6 external door

**Spring Term Parents' Evening** was originally scheduled for the last week of term.

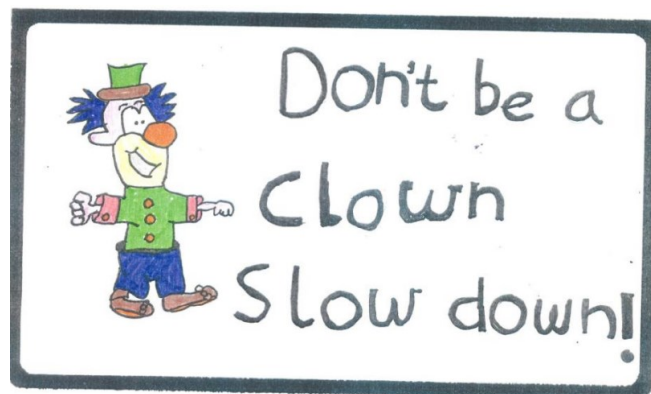

All entries should be reach the school by **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> March**.

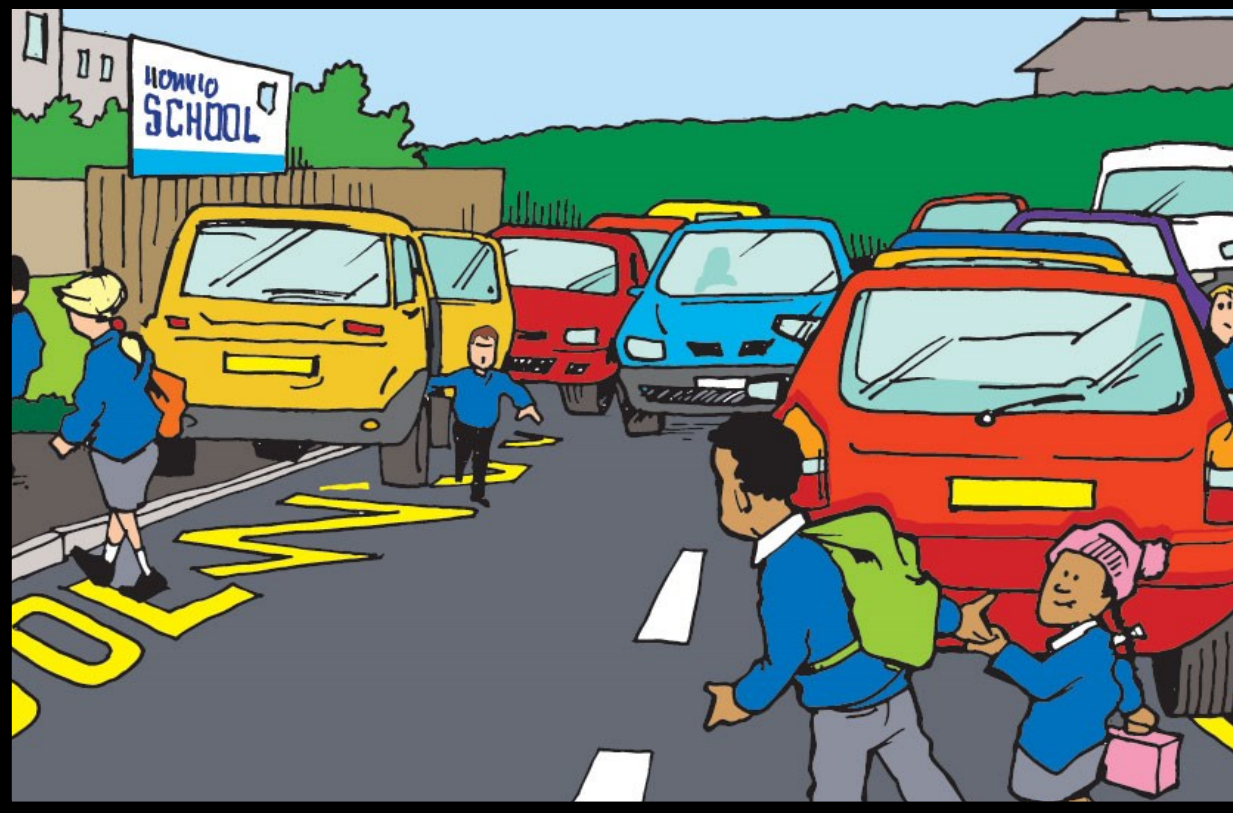
Original paper designs can be posted into a special collection box outside the school office
