Football

There have been a number of games in a variety of competitions. In the sports partnership cluster competition at Wolfreton in October, our two teams performed brilliantly against 8 other teams. We managed an amazing second place overall, only losing out to Kirkella on goal difference by one single goal. In the Hull City EFL cup at Hull University in November, our first team did one better, winning all our ties and qualifying for the final which will be held in January. Finally, our team of girls also played a tie against Elloughton girls. Considering this was their first ever game, a 2-0 win was a superb result.



Cross country
