We have had a very busy term again, with many sporting events, mainly involving finals from earlier rounds.

Football

Our Year 6 boys competed in the EFL cup finals on 25th January at the Airco Arena. We won a couple but finished 3rd in our group, just missing out on a semi-final place.

Our Year 5/6 girls' squad played a warm-up friendly against Mount Pleasant in March, winning 1 game, losing 1 and drawing the rest. We then travelled to Nottingham on 9th March for the East Midlands county final, having been crowned County Champions in December.
