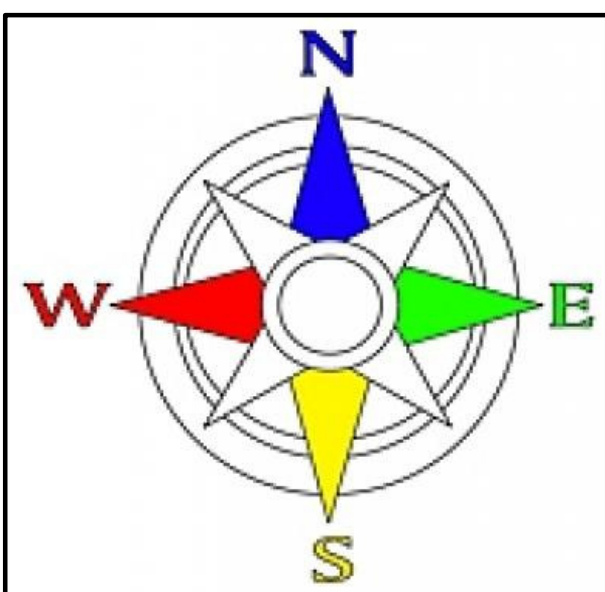

| What are human and physical features? | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • physical features are naturally occurring and include beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather • human features are things built by humans and include city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop |
| What are the four compass points? | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 4 compass points are North, South, East and West • The compass points can be used when identifying the location of countries in the UK • The compass points can be used when locating places and landmarks on a range of maps (world, street, country) |

compass points	any of the main points of a compass: north, south, east and west
country	an area of land that is controlled by its own government
Edinburgh	Edinburgh is the capital city of Scotland
England	a country in the United Kingdom Willerby is a village in England
flag	a piece of cloth which can be attached to a pole and which is used as symbol of a particular country
Globe	A spherical object with a map of the world on it
Great Britain	An island that is made up of England, Scotland and Wales
human geography	features of land that have been impacted by human activity
island	a piece of land that is completely surrounded by water
London	London is the capital city of England and the UK
National flower	A flower that represents the country
Northern Ireland	A country in the United Kingdom
physical geography	natural features of land
Scotland	A country in the United Kingdom
sea	a large area of salty water that is part of an ocean
Street view	View from the ground
United Kingdom	The UK, is officially known as the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland It includes England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland
village	a small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside (e.g. Willerby, Anlaby, Kirk Ella and Hessle)
Wales	A country in the United Kingdom














