How has Carr Lane Primary School changed over time?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carr Lane Primary was the first school in Willerby. • It first opened in 1937 • There were 7 classes with 40 children in each class • Carr Lane Primary school amalgamated 2007 and moved to a new building in 2009 • We now have 14 classes. • It was in a two story building • It had no flushing toilets
How Willerby is different now from in the past?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Willerby had a railway station which is now closed. • Willerby was a small village but has increased in population over the years.

Key Dates / Timeline

Date	Event
1844	Willerby's population was 214 people in 45 houses.
1850's	A Methodist Chapel and Willerby Hall was built.
1885	Willerby and Kirkella railways station was opened.
1890	Willerby Manor and The Grange were built.
1959	Willerby and Kirkella railway station closed.
1936's	Willerby Carr Lane Primary School was built.
1960	Wolfreton School was opened
1960 - present	Willerby continues to expand with the development of many houses.
2011	Population 7,900 people.
2012	Carr Lane Junior School demolished
2016	Wolfreton Upper school closed.

Historical Investigations

- Ask questions about how Willerby has changed
- Interview people who have spent all their life in Willerby.
- Compare Willerby in the past to Willerby today. Looking at photographs and maps.
- Examine old photos and log books from school over time to see how school has changed
