Can you find something that is made from:  • wood?  • plastic?  • metal?  • glass?	Objects all around us are made out of something that has come from somewhere.
What do you know about:  • wood?  • plastic?  • metal?  • glass?	<ul> <li>Wood</li> <li>comes from trees</li> <li>paper and card come from trees</li> <li>the trees have to be chopped down and then turned into these things</li> <li>can be painted in different colours or can be left natural</li> <li>Metal</li> <li>comes from rocks from underground</li> <li>rocks are heated in a furnace to get the metal out of them</li> <li>can then be used to make things</li> <li>Plastic</li> <li>is made from oil and other things</li> <li>is made in a factory, where the oil needs to be heated up.</li> <li>can be made in lots of different colours.</li> <li>It can be made to look like other things e.g. wood or glass</li> <li>Glass</li> <li>is made in a factory, using a furnace</li> <li>can be made in different colours</li> <li>is sharp if broken and could injure us</li> </ul>
Why do we make out of?	Certain materials are better for one purpose than another e.g. glass for windows because it is see through

e.g. windows out of glass	<ul> <li>and lets light in, but not used for babies toys because it breaks easily and can be sharp.</li> <li>Some objects e.g. bowls, can be made from glass, plastic, metal or wood.</li> <li>Many objects are made of more than 1 material.</li> </ul>
What can you tell me about this object?	<ul> <li>Not all objects feel the same or look the same.</li> <li>We can use certain words to describe how objects feel or look (shiny/dull, soft/hard, rough/smooth)</li> </ul>

dull	lacking in brightness, not reflecting light.	
factory	a building where things are made.	
furnace	a large, hot oven used to change things.	
glass	a material made from sand and other things.	
<mark>hard</mark>	firm, not easily broken or bent.	
materials	what something is made of.	
metal	a solid material that comes from rocks.	
object	a thing that can be seen and touched.	
plastic	a material made from oil.	
purpose	the reason for which we use something.	
<mark>rough</mark>	having an uneven or bumpy surface; not smooth.	
<mark>shiny</mark>	having a smooth surface, reflecting light	
<mark>smooth</mark>	having an even and regular surface	
soft	having a smooth surface, not rough, not hard or firm to the touch.	
wood	a material that comes from a tree.

### Some children may think:

- only fabrics are materials
- only building materials are materials
- only writing materials are materials
- the word 'rock' describes an object rather than a material
- 'solid' is another word for hard.
