

The Joy of Early Years Foundation Stage


Spending time in our new, spacious and inviting EYFS setting is an absolute joy — the children are always found engrossed in choosing their learning, exploring, experimenting, collaborating and creating. Staff work hard to incorporate the children's passions and interests in their teaching and to provoke their learning — encouraging *playing and exploring*: children investigate and experience things, and 'have a go'; *active learning*: children concentrate and keep on trying if they find things difficult, and enjoy achievements; *creating and thinking critically*: children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas, and develop strategies for doing things.

The Early Years Foundation Stage is such an important year for children— the wealth of existing evidence is clear that high-quality effective early years provision has a significant impact on children's social, emotional and cognitive development and is a key factor in improving outcomes for children and families. It narrows the gap between the highest and lowest performers and gives all children the positive start to play and learning that they need. Take a walk through our EYFS setting on any morning or afternoon and you would see that in action...

All Systems Go !



We also have children who can become unwell and then need help to catch-up. For these reasons, we still operate an intense cleaning operation. We also have a wide range of before school, during school and after school additional targeted, recovery intervention classes running.

However, the good news is that all normal aspects of school have returned and we look forward to an Autumn term with Halloween events, remembrance day, and, of course, Christmas parties, Christmas dinners, carols and nativities from our EYFS and our Year 4 classes.


