# What is an ELSA?

ELSAs are Emotional, Literacy Support Assistants. Thev are specialist teaching assistants with a wealth of experience working with children. ELSAs are trained and regularly supervised by an Educational Psychologist.

An ELSA is a warm and caring person who wants to help your child feel happy in school and to reach their full potential. Their aim is to build your child's emotional development and help them cope with life's challenges.

### Mrs Chawner

You will see Mrs Chawner every morning greeting children and parents at the front of school. If you have any concerns about your child, however big or small, she is more than happy to have a quick chat with you. She will to offer you her expert be able advice on the spot or if she feels more time may be needed to support your child she will discuss some ways forward with the SENDCo. Don't forget she is here to support not only your child, but you as parents/carers too! We know you have a tough job on your hands bringing up these little humans and the start of a new school year in particular can be tough.

## Speech and Language

Miss Clark works with children who have speech and language needs. She works closely with the Speech and Language team from the East Riding to deliver programs of work as prescribed for individual children.

Miss Clark also delivers Interventions before school, after school and during lunchtimes.

### **Phonics**

Miss Bolin and Mrs Overment help with phonics interventions. They help children who need a bit more practise learning the phonic sounds, particularly children in year 1 and 2.
