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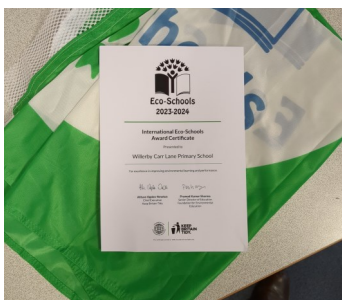
Willerby Carr Lane Primary School Newsletter

School Games Mark Award

The School Games Mark is an award scheme designed to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across the school. For a number of years, we have been awarded Gold which recognises the large amount of intra and inter school competitions we enter throughout the year of a variety of levels and disciplines and the number of opportunities we also provide e.g. for play leaders. This year we were awarded **the highest level of Platinum** for the first time, which celebrates the extra steps we have taken to encourage our pupils to get involved. The picture includes a group of our Marathon club runners, which is a prime example of one of the ways we are involving children in competition, where they strive to achieve their personal bests in terms of distances run over a term.

This was an idea of Mr Scott's which has become very popular, even with reluctant runners!

We look forward to being able to continue championing school sports throughout this coming year.
