Purpose

At Carr Lane Primary School, we believe that what people wear affects the way they behave. The following school uniform policy is intended to foster positive working attitudes and pride in the school. It also aids social equality. The uniform policy is similar in principle to that required at Wolfreton, and so prepares children for their transfer.

We believe that children should be dressed as children appropriate to their age. Children should not wear nail varnish, jewellery, make up or any tattoos, including the stick-on variety. Small stud earrings may be worn in ears, if the ear has been pierced.

PE Health and Safety

For reasons of hygiene children must be in PE kit for all PE and games lessons. Children may come to school in PE kits on the day they have PE.

Stud earrings must be removed. Where earrings cannot be removed, i.e. during the eight week period following the date of piercing, parents should provide tape to cover them.
